## ROOMS

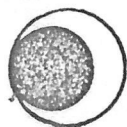
Please lock your room if no one is in.

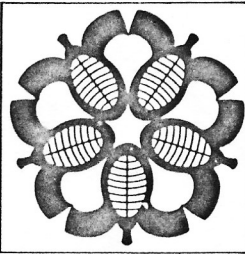
