Please note the following points:

1) 28th July (Tue): Check in at the "Suido-bashi Green Hotel" late afternoon. A meeting will be held from 18:00 to 19:00 the same evening.

12:00 - 13:30 The Opening Ceremony will be held at Kudan-Kaikan.

14:00 Transfer to the Camp yenue mentioned below by train.

3) 9th August (Sun): Morning

Closing Ceremony at Renshinkan-Dojo.

Transfer to Ueno Station (in Tokyo) by train. Break-up at Ueno Station (at the Parkside Gate) just before noon.

- 4) Detailed programme of the Seminars will be mailed at a later date.
- 5) All official expenses in Tokyo and Kitamoto shall be borne by ZNKR. (This does not include transportation fee between Narita Airport and Tokyo, and personal expenses.)
- 6) For reservations at the Suido-bashi Green Hotel before 28th July or after 9th August, please let me know in advance.

Rate for single room is \$5,500, and twin is \$8,800.

- 7) Before your departure, be sure to take out an insurance policy in your own country against accidents during your stay in Japan.
- 8) Please bring with you the following items:

Bogu, Shinai (two or more), Keikogi (two if possible), Hakama, Tenugui, Sports wear, Bath towel, Name for "Tare".

Please also bring the following if you possess them:

Katana for Iai (only imitation), Bokuto, Texts - "Fundamental Kendo", "Iai", "Match Rules".

- Note: a) You may buy everything mentioned above on the 28th
 July in the evening.
 - b) Since summer in Japan is humid, there is no need to bring a regular suit.
- 9) Those who wish to try the Dan-examinations for 2 to 5 Dan (Kendo and/or Iai) are requested to bring the Kendo passport issued by each organization or their latest Dan certificate.
