BELGIUM

All Belgium Kendo Federation

A.B.K.F. is the bridging organization between the Belgian Kendo Renmei (previous member of IKF) and the National Kendo Federation, and is based on the agreement under the "Coordination Committee for the Belgian Kendo."

BRAZIL

Paulista Kendo Federation

All Brazil Kendo Federation (previous member of IKF) was newly registered by the government, and changed its name to Paulista Kendo Federation.

Above mentioned organizations were recognized as members of I.K.F.

ITALY

In Italy, there is a fierce argument going on between A.I.K., a member of IKF (Headquarters in Milan), and F.I.S., an official member of National Olympic Committee of Italy (CONI) (Headquarters in Rome), about supremacy.

As a result of the discussion, further investigation and arbitration of the dispute has been referred to a committee comprised by a trio, Mr. R. Von Sandor, Vice President of IKF, Mr. T. Kasahara, Secretary General of IKF, and Mr. V. Harris, President of European Kendo Federation. It was settled that the final decision shall be made at B.O.D. Meeting, 1984.

REGULATIONS FOR KENDO MATCHES

ADDENDUM

July 30th. 1982

(1) Ref. Art.19 - Item 1)

The following actions shall be considered as being JOGAI, not impetus :-

- a) When a contestant runs out of the match area rather with intention than with impetus of DATOTSU.
- b) When a contestant steps out of the match area after attempting DATOTSU from TSUBAZERIAI and the intention of that attempt is judged to be to avoid his position of disadvantage.

(2) Ref. Art.3 - (Note B)

Shall be partially amended to read as follows :- (Previous omitted)

Then, adopting TAITO, each will take three steps forward starting with the right foot and take the SONKYO position while drawing the SHINAI.

After the result of a match has been announced, both opponents will take the SONKYO position while putting up the SHINAI, then step back starting with the left foot, to the original position and bow to each other in SAGETO.

(3) Ref. Art.19 - Item 10).....(Example)

In the separating action from TSUBAZERIAI, one gave a thrust to the opponent with the tip of SHINAI intentionally.

In this case, the violator will be given corrective advice by Referee; however, if he repeats the same violation, it will be deemed as unfair, and it constitutes HANSOKU.

(4) Ref. Art.17 - Item 1) - (Note)

When SHINAI is held with its TSURU facing to the left or to the right, corrective advice will be given by Referee. If it will be not corrected, however, any DATOTSU performed in that condition will be rejected as invalid.

The Proposal was approved unanimously.

VENUE AND DATE FOR THE 6TH
WORLD KENDO CHAMPIONSHIPS 1985

Mr. Y. Mautret, Chairman of French National Committee of Kendo / F.F.J.D.A., made a proposal as follows concerning the candidacy of France as the venue for 6WKC.

Venue: Paris (Coubertin Gymnasium)

The French proposal was approved unanimously.

BOARD OF DIRECTORS' MEETING 1983

It was decided that the B.O.D. Meeting 1983 shall be held "by written correspondence" in accordance with Appendix Article 3 of IKF Constitution.

ENACTMENT OF THE EMBLEM OF IKF

The following is the result of vote cast for the 51 designs entered by Brazil, China, France, Hawaii, Japan and Switzerland.

1st place : Design by Mr. K. Nakazawa (Brazil)

2nd place : Design by Mr. J. Clerc (Switzerland)

P.S. It was found that the most popular design was quite unexpectedly similar to the emblem chosen by "International Social Kendo Club" in 1967. The final decision will be made at the next IKF Meeting. (T. Kasahara)

PROPOSALS

- (1) Mr. Roy Asa (Canada), Director of IKF

Would like to see IKF officially commend those who endeavoured to lay out the foundation or contributed greatly towards the development of kendo in each country.

The proposal won the approval of the majority. The basis for commendation and method of presentation will be discussed at the next IKF Meeting.

- (2) Mr. Roberto Del Miglio, President of Italian Kendo Association (AIK)

-- Proposal presented in writing. Mr. M. Bottoni made the explanation. --

Would like to amend the following points of IKF Constitution.

- 1) Driving out of a national member from IKF.
- 2) Substitution of a national member in IKF.
- 3) Extension of the rules concerning application for admission of new members.

Concerning the proposal, both President F. Dettwiler (Switzerland) and President Lim Kwa Chwee (Singapore) sent in contrary opinion, also in writing, that there is no need for such amendments.

At the next B.O.D. Meeting, it will be decided whether to adopt this proposal as a motion or not.

- (3) Mr. Kim Dong Soo (Korea), Vice President of IKF

- a) Would like to invite the 7th WKC, 1988 to Korea.
- b) Would like kendo to be included among events in the Olympic Games.

The proposal will be deferred as theme for further study.
