1. Term: 25th July through 6th August, 1983
  - { 25th July (Mon) evening - assemble at the designated lodging in Tokyo
  - { 6th August (Sat) noon - break-up at Ueno-station in Tokyo
2. Place: Gedatsukai Renshinkan-Dojo  
Kitamoto-shi, Saitama-Prefecture  
(one hr. from Tokyo Station by train)
3. Qualification of Participants:
  - a) Members of your organization.
  - b) Those born on or before 1 Aug., 1965.
  - c) In principle, those who are holders of Dan.
4. Course of Seminar: Manners, Fundamental Practice,  
Drill in Techniques, Kendo-Kata,  
Iaido, Match and Judging, Ji-Geiko,  
Lectures, and etc.
5. Number of Participants:
  - a) Total number is limited to thirty-five.
  - b) Four persons may apply from each organization. If more than four desire to participate, please recommend them as substitutes, and list them in the order of your recommendation.
  - c) If the total number of applicants is less than 35, ZNKR will review your recommendation to make up 35, with a priority on new applicants.
6. Dan Examination: ZNKR Dan (1 through 5/Kendo & Iaido) Examination will be held for the participants who wish to take Dan.

7. Expense:           a) Each participant will pay for his own round-trip ticket to Tokyo.
- b) ZNKR will bear the expenses during the Camp (accommodation, meals, Tokyo-Kitamoto transportation, and parties)

8. Application: Please fill in the enclosed application form and mail it back to ZNKR.

Your application must reach ZNKR by 31st May, 1983.

ZNKR approval of applications will be notified you of by 20th June, 1983.



- 3) 6th August (Sat): Morning Closing Ceremony at Renshinkan-Dojo.  
Transfer to Ueno Station (in Tokyo) by train.  
Break-up at Ueno Station (at the Parkside Gate) just before noon.

- 4) Detailed programme of the Seminars is as per enclosed sheet,
- 5) All official expenses in Tokyo and Kitamoto shall be borne by ZNKR. (This does not include transportation fee between Narita Airport and Tokyo, and personal expenses.)
- 6) Before your departure, be sure to take out an insurance policy in your own country against accidents during your stay in Japan.
- 7) Please bring with you the following items:  
Bogu, Shinai (two or more), Keikogi (two if possible), Hakama, Tenugui, Sports wear, Bath towel, Name for "Tare".  
Please also bring the following if you possess them:  
Katana for Iai (only imitation), Bokuto, Knee-protector, Texts - "Fundamental Kendo", "Iai", "Match Rules".  
Note: a) You may buy everything mentioned above on the 25th July in the evening.  
b) Since summer in Japan is humid, there is no need to bring a regular suit.
- 8) Should you carry a real Katana, you must declare it to the custom upon your entry at Narita.
- 9) Those who wish to try the Dan-examinations for 2 to 5 Dan (Kendo and/or Iai) are requested to bring the Kendo passport issued by each organization or their latest Dan certificate.
