EUROPEAN KENDO SEMINAR 1984

Dear Kendoka,

We are pleased to send you the final details about the Kendo Seminar which will be held immediately following the European Kendo Championships on 19 and 20 May 1984.

The seminar will be held from the 21st till the 24th May in the excellent surroundings of the sports center of the Universite Catholique de Louvain at Blocry. For those who wish there will be hotel accomodation right next to the sports halls (see map).

We have been able to lower the price as initially announced. This, we hope, will enable every interested kendoka to attend this unique event. Although the number of participants is not limited per country, the total number is. Therefore, registrations will be accepted in the order in which they arrive.

The closing date for registrations is May 10th. A registration will only be considered accepted when payment has been received. The payment can be sent by bank transfer or by cheque accompanying the registration form. If you send the letter by registered mail, please address it to the treasurer personally. You will find the necessary information further in this letter.

As a kind of postscriptum, a few details which may prove fairly important to some of you have to be clarified.

First of all, we can name the Japanese delegation coming to the European Championships to act as Official or as instructor.

Officials: Ohshima and Kasahara sensei.

Takizawa sensei (8th dan hanshi);  
Mutoh sensei (8th dan kyôshi);  
Hirakawa sensei (7th dan kyôshi) and  
Shioiri sensei (7th dan kyôshi).

Next, a few Europeans have been admitted to judge the combats, unless they are participating themselves of course. These are the names:

Herr Wolfgang DEMSKI (5th dan),  
Dr Med Paul Otto FORSTREUTER (5th dan) and  
Herr Rainer JATTKOWSKI (5th dan) from Germany;  
Mr Anthony HOPSON (5th dan renshi) from England;  
Mr Hein ODINOT (4th dan) from the Netherlands and  
mr Jean-Claude TUVI (5th dan) from France

These persons are kindly requested to confirm us if they accept the task.

Then there are a few novelties regarding the second dan-grading examination after the last session of the seminar, on the 24th of May. As we mentioned in a previous letter the examination after the Championships will handle applications up to fifth dan. The second one though will go up to fourth dan "only", this as well for Kendô as for Iai. Another important fact to mention is that any applicant who failed to pass the first test is allowed to enter the second and try it again. Of course we suppose the second one can only be favourable for those who have followed the seminar. Otherwise, the second try won't nor can't be much different to the first. Miracles are not considered here ...

If you didn't know yet (it was mentioned by Mr Hirakawa during the last meeting of the E.K.F.), please note that written applications for the examinations, informing about the present grade and the date of the former test, should be sent to the secretary of the Championships in advance, or handed in personally at last on Friday the 18th of May. So, if you plan to arrive on Saturday, please don't forget to mail yours to avoid unpleasant surprises!

We sincerely hope that after this letter no more problems remain. If not, don't hesitate to contact us. Anyway, we hope to meet you all in the optimal mental and physical condition next month! See you then.

REGISTRATION: Open until 10th May. The total number of participants is limited. There is no limit per country. Registration is only considered final when we receive full payment. Payments can be made by bank transfer or using a cheque accompanying your registration forms.

WITHDRAWAL POLICY: Prior to May 10th all but 2,000 BF will be returned upon cancelation in writing.

PARTIAL ATTENDANCE: Is only allowed for a non-interrupted number of days starting at the beginning of the seminar. I.e. one can attend on Monday only or Monday and Tuesday, but not Monday and Wednesday or from Tuesday onwards.

**DATES:** 21st until 24th May included.

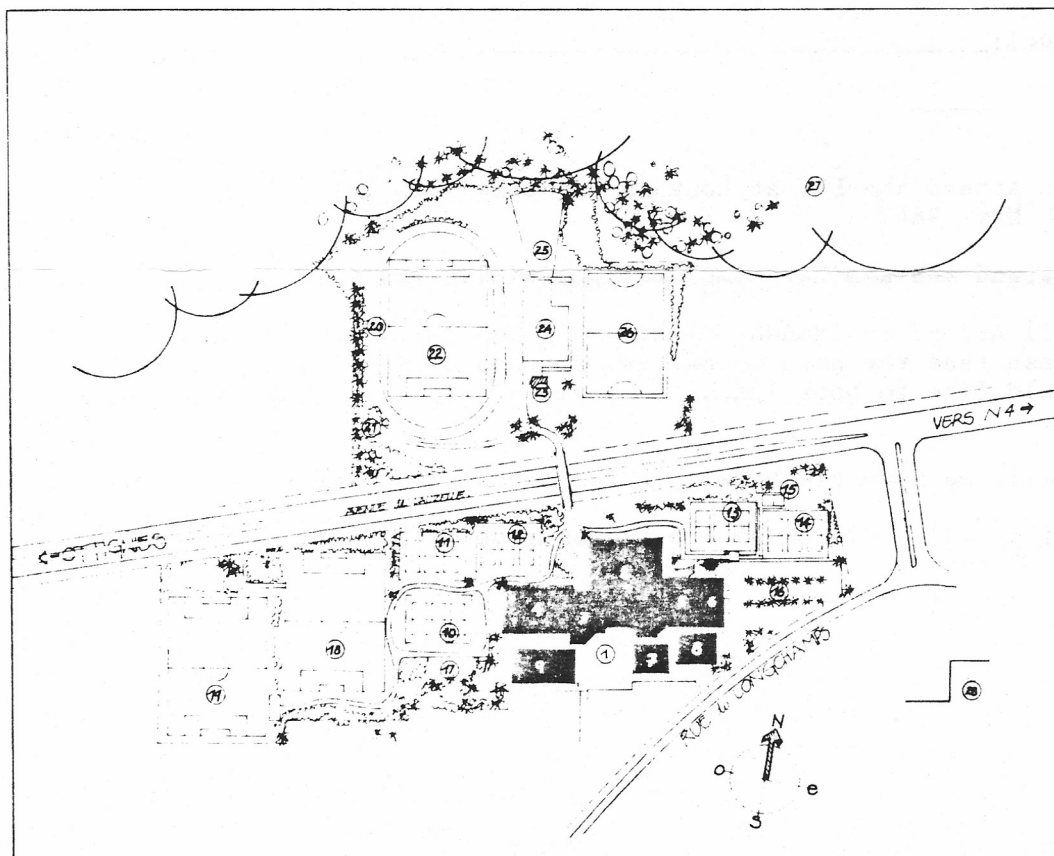
**SCHEDULE:** Monday-Thursday: seminar mornings and afternoon. Thursday evening there will be a farewell party.
