9. Further information in detail will be mailed at the beginning of July.

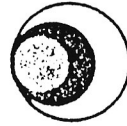

HOW TO GET TO KITAMOTO.

From Narita international airport to Kitamoto count 4 hours to be on the safe side.

When exchanging money at the airport, ask for a few 1,000 yen notes as ticket vending machines accept this note which makes the purchase of your train tickets easy.

Narita Int'l Airport Take a bus at Number "4" bus stops. Bus is called
↓ By Bus "Shuttle to Keisei Narita Station".

Keisei Narita Airport Station

↓ By Train About 2 hours by "stopping train" and 1 hour & a half
 by "express" trains.

Keisei Ueno Station 150 meters apart.

↓ On Foot

JR Ueno Station (Some officials will be waiting for you at Ueno Station.

↓ By Train (Takasaki Line)

There are many trains from Ueno to Kitamoto, however, we strongly suggest you try to get on one of the two following:

12:33(Track #9) and 12:50 (Track #25) to take advantage of the of
ficials' presence at Ueno Station on departure of those trains,
as well as a bus pick-up service upon arrival at Kitamoto Station.

Kitamoto Station It takes about 1 hour from Ueno to Kitamoto.

↓ On Foot About 10 minutes.
