Re : Foreigners' Kendo Summer Seminar, 1989

We are pleased to announce our programme for the 14th Summer Camp of 1989 as described below and are looking forward to your members' enthusiastic participation, again.

1. Term : 24th July through 3rd August, 1989

24th July (Mon) noon : check-in at the Gedatsukai Kenshu Center

3rd August (Thu) noon : break-up at Ueno Station

2. Place : Gedatsukai Kenshu Center

Kitamoto-shi, Saitama-Pref. (one hr. from Ueno Station by train)

3. Qualification of Participants :

a) Members of your organization

b) Those born on or before 1 Aug., 1969

c) Those who have Kendo experience more than 3 years

d) Those who are current instructors or potential instructors as recommended by the president of each organization.

4. Number of Participants :

Two persons in accordance with the qualifications mentioned above may be accepted per organization. The total number is limited to fifty in terms of the male participant ; however, if female participants are involved, we consider forty-two male and eight female as its actual accommodation capacity. No more than fifty participants can be accepted.

5. Extra Participation :

If your organization has more than two applicants, please give your priority in number from 1 and on. Only provided the accomodation capacity exceeds the total number of nominal participants, a few extra participants may be accepted on a first-come first-served basis, for their account of lodging and meal expenses.

6. Course of Seminar : Manners, Fundamental Practice,
Drill in Techniques, Kendo-Kata, Iaido,
Match & Judging, Ji-Geiko, Lectures, etc.

7. Dan Examination : Z.N.K.R. Dan (1 through 5 / Kendo & Iaido) Examination will be held for the participants but optional. The application for this examination will be handled separately.


8. Expense : a) Each participant will pay for his own round-trip ticket to Tokyo.
b) Z.N.K.R. will bear the expenses during the course of training. (accommodation, meals and parties).
