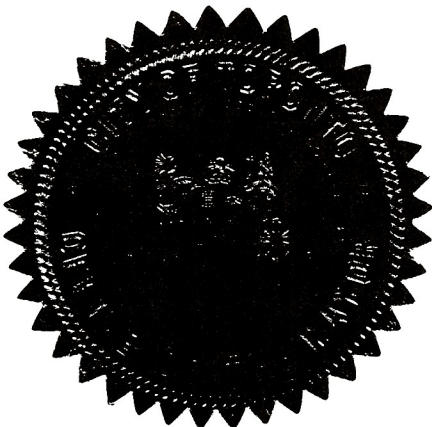

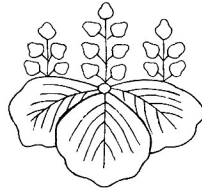
Kendo, meaning "the way of the sword", is a centuries-old Japanese martial art practised by samurai to master swordsmanship, courage and concentration.

I would like to close by thanking our many sponsors for their generous support. Please enjoy the **8th World Kendo Championships**.

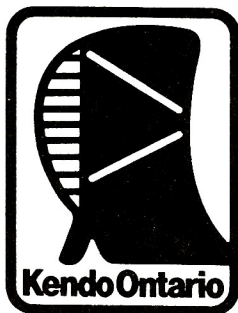

HOW TO WATCH A KENDO MATCH



There are four main target areas, sub-divided into left and right sides of the body — each worth one point. These are cuts to the head (MEN), the wrist (KOTE), torso (DO), and a thrust to the throat or upper chest (TSUKI). The competitors call their attempted strikes in a strong voice (KIAI) and blows must be delivered with the upper third of the bamboo blade. Although it may appear that many cuts are finding their targets in the course of a match, a stroke must be co-ordinated with correct footwork, Kiai (shout), good posture and strong follow-through in order to be considered successful.

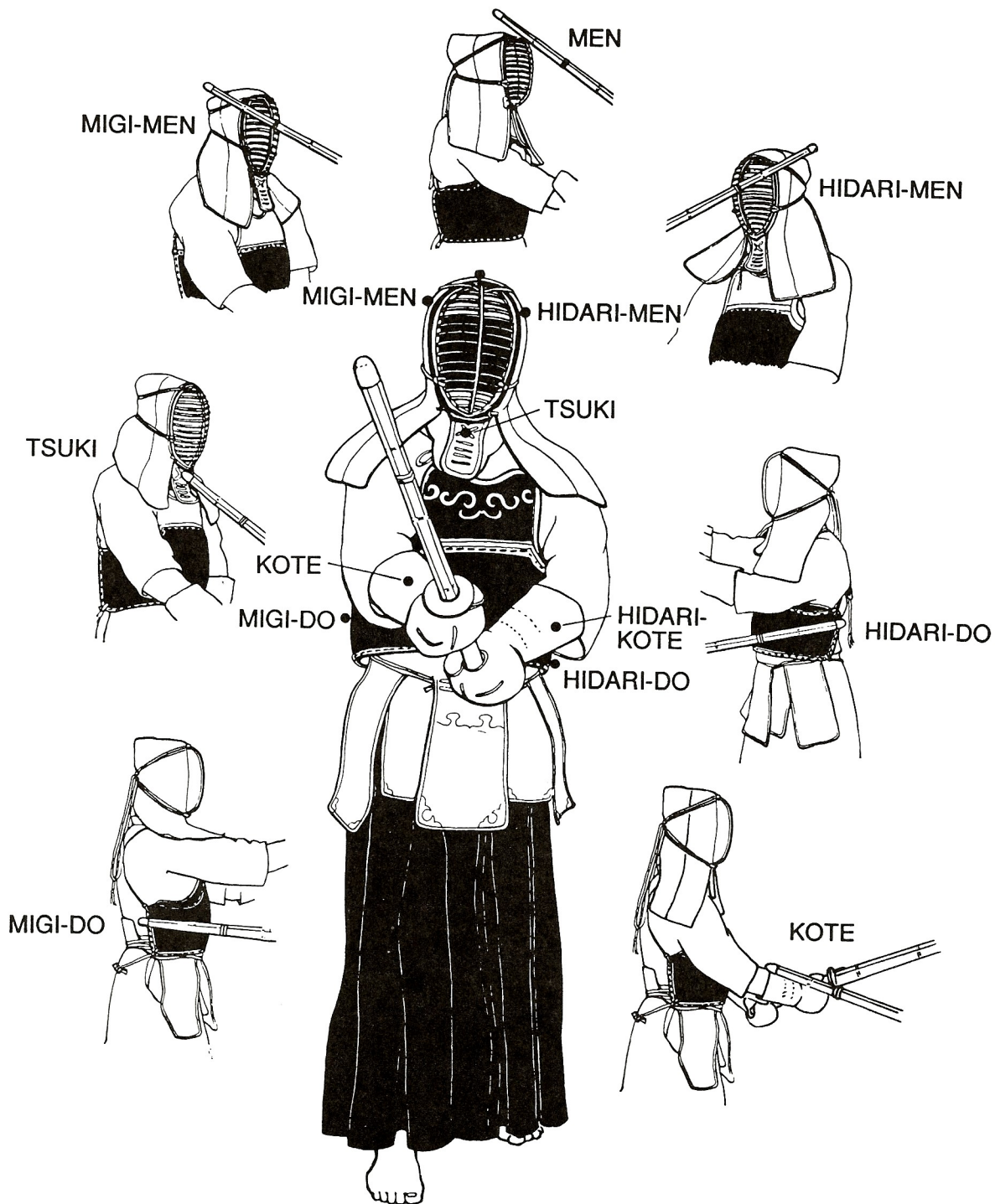
The three referees indicate points scored by snapping red or white flags overhead; at least two must agree for the point to be awarded. A fast criss-crossing of the flags at hip-level means the official did not consider a cut valid. The match is halted after each successful point, to be resumed at centre-court upon the chief referee's signal. Two good points delivered simultaneously cancel one another, however, and the match is not stopped. Penalties are given for stepping out of bounds, dropping one's SHINAI and poor sportsmanship. If a contestant accumulates two such penalties in the course of a match, one point is awarded to the opponent.

Individual matches are fought for two out of three points over a time period of from two to five minutes. Upon expiration of time, a scoreless or tied match may be extended until a deciding point is scored. In the case of primary matches, it is now common in the event of a draw, for a winner to be declared by a referee's consensus, based on the contestant who showed better form, fighting spirit, etc.

Team competition ordinarily comprises five member teams whose opposing pairs face each other in turn, ending with the captains. The winning team is determined by either the total number of points scored or the majority of individual winners.
