Thank you for your kind letter and please accept my excuses for such a long delay from my side. Let me also congratulate you the wonderful trip to Japan and to the Far East. We - in Poland - may rather only dream about it! So - we hope that soon there will be an occasion to see you and hear your impressions.

I passed your greetings and invitation to my friends, Polish kendokas who thank you.

And now let me explain the delay of our answer.

Like in the past years we tried to get an official permission from the Polish sports authorities to send our representation to European Kendo Championships. Only several months of our efforts ... and now we see again that there is no chance to fix it this way.

However, we have decided to do all what is possible to participate in the 8th EKC. The distance to Malmö is short and costs of travel is relatively small. And ... first of all ... we irresistibly wish and will meet the best Europe's kendokas.

However, in this case we need your help, indeed!

The problem is that we shall not receive official sports passports. So, we need private tourists invitations for each member of our team individually. IMPORTANT! The invitation forms must be confirmed in the Polish Embassy or consulate in Sweden.

When we have them we can apply for private passports and visas.

There is our favour we would like to ask you to prepare 11 personal invitations. We hope you will be able to help us in this matter. We shall refund all costs after our arrival to Sweden.

Please pass our best wishes to the Kendo-friends in Sweden.

Good luck on your "way of sword" in the coming year.


