Re. EC⁴-1972 in Kendo

With today's mail undersigned have received a letter from the Swiss Kendo Federation which announces that they cannot participate in the planned EC competitions.

I have also received a letter from England where the English Kendo Federation regrets but due to lacking financial resources they cannot participate in the competitions.

FFJDA – head organization for the French federation announces that they have internal - kendo political – difficulties with the selection to the official national team.

With the above as background, I consider it impossible to arrange an EC in kendo with only Sweden and West-Germany.

In addition, comes the lack of satisfactory organizational guarantees.

I therefore request that SBF cancels the EC competitions.
