The Origin of the Kasahara Cup

The International Kendo Federation (IKF) was founded in Tokyo by Toshiaki Kasahara under the supervision of the President Tokutaro Kimura on April, 4th 1970. During this assembly Mr. Kasahara was elected Vice President and Mr. Kimura President of the newly founded International Kendo Federation. Both of them had been previously active in the same roles in the Zen Nippon Kendo Renmei and they were very successful in their tasks. Hence they brought a lot of experience and understanding for their newly assigned duties.

The national Kendo federations were regularly instructed on the newest changes in teaching curriculum personally by Toshiaki Kasahara, who had become in the mean time IKF-General Secretary. He also visited the different countries on all continents to assist them in founding their national federations and to be himself informed on their progression.

He had an especially good relationship with Switzerland. His many visits and attention he brought to our country were locally much appreciated. An unusual honour was accorded to the our Kendo section when Mr. Kasahara sent his son Hiroaki for two years as a Kendo instructor to Switzerland.

Our patron, Toshiaki Kasahara, deceased on April, 23rd 1984 at the age of 64. The Kendo section of the Swiss Judo Federation wanted to found a Kendo tournament in order to commemorate his deeds. His wife, Mitsue Kasahara, agreed to this idea and donated the challenge cup for the team competition.

The Kasahara Cup is a yearly tournament which takes place in Switzerland during the last weekend in September. Besides the team competitions there are categories for men, women and categories for grades in dan and kyu.

The Kasahara Cup is world-wide the only cup which bears the name of Toshiaki Kasahara.
