Subject: EKF Statutes.

Dear Raf.

Upon reading the above I have found at the moment two items I would like to propose to change at the AGM of the EKF.

(1) I would like to deal with Article 06 item 05 sub para "h". We have a Technical Director who is responsible for the standards of Kendo throughout the EKF. It is not the job of the President to do this Technical work, after all we may at sometime have a person who may hold 1st Dan or no Dan at all. Therefore how can he be responsible for the activities of the Technical Committee.

I therefor propose that this section should be rewritten as follows.

He is responsible for submitting to the EKF General Assembly any technical information or criterion supplied to him by the Technical Committee for ratification.

(2) Article 08 Sub para "a".

It is the job of the Technical Director to call such meetings that are necessary and to establish the agenda, the EKF President may be invited, BUT cannot take the Chair as this conflicts with Article 08 sub para "b".


One must always remember the Technical Director is elected by the technical committee to represent them on the B.O. I therefor propose that this article should be rewritten as follows.

He shall call together the Technical Committee and establish the agenda for each reunion.
