- c) Schedule of Kendo training course

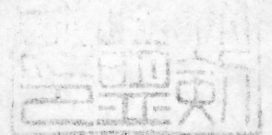
I hope you will take full advantage of this kendo mission and I trust that they are of your good help for development of Kendo.
