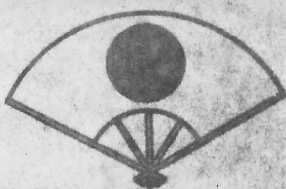

Entries are invited from all Kendoka in shodan, nidan and sandan ranks inclusive.  
There is no limitation to nationality, the only requirement is that entrants must  
be authorised members of their respective national Kendo Renmei or in the case of  
British Kendoka, must hold a current Individual Membership of this Renmei.

An nominal entrance fee of 15p will be charged at the time of registration to cover  
some of the Renmei expenses.

Entries must reach the Secretary of the Renmei not later than Wednesday 11th October  
together with the entry fee.

1972 marks the 10th Anniversary of the founding of the British Kendo Renmei so the  
Chairman and officers of the Renmei would like to see a very large turn-out for this  
important event.

Japan Air Lines are donating the trophies and a special award will be made by the  
Renmei to mark the occasion.
