
1. Date: 2 - 14 August 1977 (13 days)
 { 1 Aug (Mon) - assemble in Tokyo
 in the evening.
 14 Aug (Sun) - break-up at Tokyo
 at noon.
2. Place: Gedatsukai Renshinkan Dojo
 Kitamoto-shi, Saitama Prefecture
 (1 hr. from Tokyo either by train
 or car)
3. Details of Seminar: Manners, Fundamental Practice,
 Drill in Techniques, Kendo-Kata,
 Iai, Match and Judging, Ji-Geiko,
 and Lectures.
4. Special Programmes: a) 8 Aug. - a short tour or rest
 b) 13 Aug. - ZNKR Dan (1-5) Exami-
 nation will be held for the
 participants who wish to take
 one.
5. Instructors: 7 masters, all of whom are high-
 ranking in Japan.

6. Qualifications: a) Members of organizations affiliated to IKF.
b) In principle, male 18 yrs. and over.
7. Number of Participants: Note. Ladies & Companions cannot lodge together.
As a rule, participation will be limited to four members from each organization.
8. Fee: a) Each participant will be asked to pay for his own round-trip ticket to and fro Tokyo.
b) ZNKR will bear the expenses during the Camp (accomodation, meals, domestic transportation, and reception), except for personal spendings.
9. Application: Please fill in the enclosed application form and mail it back to ZNKR. Your application must reach ZNKR by 20 June 1977.

For your information, let me add that we will be enjoying the exclusive use of the Dojo and the newly built accomodation facilities for this Summer Camp. In other words, no other groups will be allowed in to use these facilities during the period. Further detailed information will be sent to each participant at a later date.
