I. RESULTS OF THE GREAT BRITAIN VS FRANCE GOODWILL MATCHES

On 20 February 1977, a goodwill match between the Great Britain team and the French team was held at Aubergenville in the suburbs of Paris. In the team match, consisting of 10 players from the two countries, the French defeated the Great Britain team with a score of 6 wins, 2 losses and 2 draws. Then, a 12-member team match, using the knock-down method, followed, with two Belgian players joining the G.B. team. Paglieri (France) started the fight by crushing three opponents, but the G.B. team rolled back the tide of the match, with G. Sterckx (Belgium) defeating five, and T. Holt, three opponents. French subcaptain Deguitre fought well, beating four opponents, until he was defeated by A.P. Hopson, captain of the G.B. team. Thus a duel between the two captains took place. The French captain, Roland, hit Hopson's MEN, and brought victory to his team, in response to the enthusiastic cheers of an audience of 500.

II. RESULTS OF THE 2ND EUROPEAN CHAMPIONSHIPS

The 2nd European Kendo Championships took place at the Petit Palais des Sports in Brussels on 9 April 1977. Delegations from the ten countries marched into the hall to the music of their respective national anthems.

Four missions dispatched by ZNKR held demonstrations and acted as referees. 55 players took part in the Individual Championship. Young players were conspicuous among the hot contests.

III. REPORTS OF THE TRAINING CAMP IN EUROPE

ZNKR promoted the first Kendo Training Camp in Europe. The Camp, organized by Nederlandse Kendo Renmei, was held from 10 to 17 April at the National Sports Centre, "Papendal" (Arnhem, Netherlands). 54 kendoka from 10 countries participated, and underwent 7 hours of hard training a day under the instruction of 7 senseis.

Papendal was equipped with excellent facilities. The Seminar was carried out effectively, and the camp ended as a great success. Dan examination was given to the 35 candidates, and 25 passed.

IV. RESULTS OF THE ALL JAPAN TEAM TOURNAMENT

On 3 May 1977, the 25th All Japan Team Tournament was held at the Osaka Central Sports Hall. 47 teams (5 players each), representing 47 Prefectures, took part.

3rd place : Kanagawa and Saga

In the All Japan Ladies Championships held on the same day, Miss M. Nemoto (Osaka, 4-dan) won the championship.
