- 1. Date: 29 July 11 August 1978

- 2. Place: Gedatsukai Renshinkan Dojo
 Kitamoto-shi, Saitama Prefecture
 (1 hr. from Tokyo either by train or car)
- 3. Course of Seminar: Manners, Fundamental Practice, Drill in Techniques, Kendo-Kata, Iai, Match and Judging, Ji-Geiko, and Lectures.
- 4. Special Programmes: a) July Opening Ceremony.
