Dear Sir:

Following the success of 1st, 2nd, and 3rd Kendo Summer Camps for Kendo-ka Abroad, we are pleased to announce our programme for yet another improved Summer Camp this year as described below. For this camp, we are eagerly looking forward to participation of as many Kendo-ka as possible.

1. Date: 29 July - 11 August 1978  
(28 July (Fri) evening - assemble in Tokyo.)  
(11 Aug (Fri) noon - break-up at Tokyo.)
2. Place: Gedatsukai Renshinkan Dojo  
Kitamoto-shi, Saitama Prefecture  
(1 hr. from Tokyo either by train or car)
3. Course of Seminar: Manners, Fundamental Practice,  
Drill in Techniques, Kendo-Kata,  
Iai, Match and Judging, Ji-Geiko,  
and Lectures.
4. Special Programmes: a) ~~28~~<sup>29</sup> July - Opening Ceremony.  
See model demonstra-  
tion, and All Japan  
Boys Tournament  
(Nippon Budokan).  
b) 4 Aug. - a short tour or rest.  
c) 10 Aug. - ZNKR Dan (1-5) Exami-  
nation will be held for the  
participants who wish to take  
one.
5. Instructors: 6 masters, all of whom are high-  
ranking in Japan.

6. Qualifications:
- a) Members of your organization.
  - b) Those born on or before 1 August, 1960.
  - c) In principle, those who are holders of Sho-Dan or higher.

7. Number of Participants: As a rule, participation will be limited to four members from each organization; and the total number of participants is limited to thirty. In case there are more than thirty members, ZNKR will make the selection of suitable participants. Priority will be given to new participants.

8. Fee:
- a) Each participant will be asked to pay for his own round-trip ticket to and from Tokyo City.
  - b) ZNKR will bear the expenses during the Camp (accommodation, meals, Tokyo-Kitamoto transportation, and receptions), except for personal spendings.

9. Application: Please fill in the enclosed application form and mail it back to ZNKR. Your application must reach ZNKR by 5 June 1978.

Further detailed information will be sent to each participant by the end of June.
