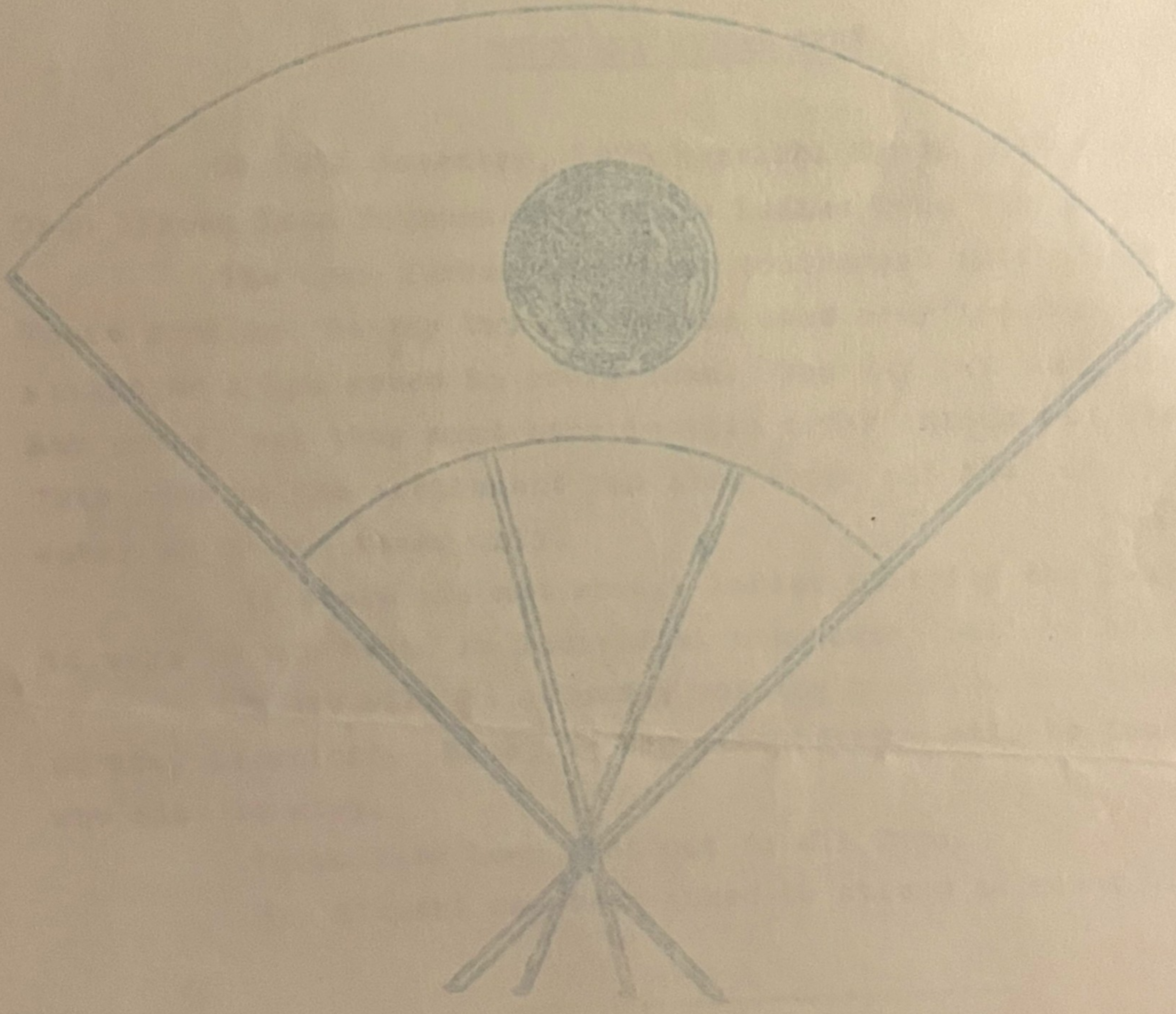

MINUTES OF A MEETING OF THE JWKC 1976 COMMITTEE
HELD AT BLETCHLEY LEISURE CENTRE ON SUNDAY, 28TH SEPT. 1975.
