**Opening ceremony**

a) **Naginata, Iaido, Jodo exhibition** (the participants have to be 3rd dan and over).  
The participants practice kata.  
5 figures of kata have to be shown  
For Naginata and Jodo, the player has to be registered with his partner  
2 or 3 shiai-jo will be used.

b) **Kendo fightings by dan** (the participants have to be 3rd dan and over).  
1 match by a fighter in principle, of 2 minutes 30 seconds by sanbon-shobu rule  
with 3 referees.  
In case of equality, the draw is declared.  
The fightings will be made by category of 3,4,5,6,7 dan  
2 or 3 shiai-jo will be used.  
The fightings' composition will be prepared by the organisation committee with  
help of authoritative experts, considering fighters' age and career.

The fightings and exhibitions list will be established and sent to each association  
two weeks before the event at the latest.

In case of applicant's cancellation after the establishment of the list here-  
above or his absence in the event, the entry fee will not be refunded in any  
case.

If an applicant knows he will be absent, he is kindly requested to inform  
immediately the Organisation Committee (CNK/FFJDA Secretary) of it.  
One player is not allowed to participate to both a) and b).

**Team tournament**

The team is composed of 3 competitors of Kendo, Naginata or mixed.  
The competitors should be 1st dan and over, from the 3rd Dan only those having attended March 14's event are admitted.

The teams are divided in the following 2 categories:

- competitors of 35 years old and under (only one member may be over 35 years old).

- competitors of 36 years old and over (only one member may be between 30 and 35 years old).

International rules of the competition and the Kendo and Naginata refereeing are applied.

1 match of 3 minutes in sanbon-shobu.

In case of equality at the end of each match, the draw is declared.

The team with higher number of matches won is declared winner.

If it breaks even, that with higher number of points scored is declared winner.

Should there still be a tie, a play-off between 2 representatives will be conducted in Ippon-shobu without time limit to determine the winner team.

The team members have to fight in the order of their age (the youngest first).

The fighting order cannot be changed.

The drawing for the tournament's composition will be made by our Organisation Committee.

Referees' groups will be composed of Japanese delegation members and those assigned by it and Organisation Committee.
