2000 (the 25th) Foreign Kendo Leaders' Summer Seminar

Dear Sir/Madam,

We are happy to announce that the captioned seminar hosted by All Japan Kendo Federation will be held as follows.

The purpose of this seminar is to foster Kendo leaders in each country, therefore we would like a lot of Kendoists who are suitable for this purpose to participate in this event. If there are people who you would like to recommend for this seminar from your organization, please refer to the following instructions and send application form to AJKF.

1. Term: July 28 (Fri) – August 4 (Fri), 2000
2. Place: Gedatsukai Kenshu Center
(Kitamoto City, Saitama Pref., Approximately 1 hour from Ueno St. by train)
3. Qualifications of Participants:
 - 1) Member of your organization and those who are recommended by the President of the organization
 - 2) Those who are instructors presently in your organization or potential instructors
 - 3) Those with 3 Dan or higher Dan in principle, or those having proficiency equivalent to 3 Dan or above
4. Expected Number of Participants: Approximately 50 in total
 - 1) The number of the applicants that are recommended by each country should be 4 or less.
 - 2) In case the total number of the applicants exceeds 50, AJKF will conduct a screening based on the priority, Dan and the past records of participation and will choose the participants.
5. How to apply:
 - 1) Deadline April 30, 2000
 - 2) Fill out the attached form "Application for 2000 Foreign Kendo Leaders' Summer Seminar", the President of the organization sign and send it back to AJKF by the deadline. We appreciate your strictly observing the deadline.
 - 3) The result of the screening (whether the applicants can participate or not) will be informed to the President by the end of May from AJKF.

6. Curriculum:

Fundamental Practice, Drill in Techniques, Kendo-Kata, Refereeing, Coaching etc.

(We will send questionnaire to each participant and ask about the subjects they want to learn in particular later.)

7. Expenses:

Each participant shall pay his/her own round-trip ticket from his/her country to Tokyo (Narita/Haneda airports). AJKF shall bear the expenses during the seminar term (accommodations and meals) and also pay up to 5,000 Yen for domestic transportation (from Narita/Haneda to Kitamoto) to each participant.


8. Subsidy:

If an applicant would like to apply for subsidy, please fill in the designated column of the application form and the Subsidy Request form attached and send them to AJKF. As AJKF conducts screening and select appropriate persons eligible for the subsidy, all that apply for subsidy are not necessarily accepted. The result of the screening for subsidy and the amount of subsidy for each person shall be notified as well by AJKF to the President when the result of the screening for the participation is notified.

9. Dan Examinations:

AJKF Dan examinations will be held for those who desire to take it on the last day of the seminar term (8/4). How to apply for the Dan examination will be informed later.
